CNC Technologies to complete three more Bell 505's – this time for the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and San Juan County Sheriff's Office.

Two will be for the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation and the third for the San Juan County Sheriff's Office in New Mexico. All three aircraft are being completed at AeroBrigham in Decatur, TX. Each aircraft will feature L3/Wescam MX10 imagers, Shotover ARS 750 moving map systems and MacroBlue monitors. Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission will have the Trakka TLX searchlight, whereas San Juan County will have the Spectrolab SX-7 searchlight. CNC is also providing their signature ongoing training and 24/7 technical support.
