## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

18 hours of classroom instruction covering the following 12 subject matter areas found on the Federal Aviation Administration's Remote Pilot Examination: Applicable regulations relating to small unmanned aircraft system rating privileges, limitations, and flight operation; Airspace classification, operating requirements, and flight restrictions affecting small unmanned aircraft operation; Aviation weather sources and effects of weather on small unmanned aircraft performance; Small unmanned aircraft loading; Emergency procedures; Crew resource management; Radio communication procedures; Determining the performance of small unmanned aircraft; Physiological effects of drugs and alcohol; Aeronautical decision-making and judgment; Airport operations; and Maintenance and preflight inspection procedures.

In addition, 3 additional briefings specific to law enforcement use of sUAS will be conducted:

- Introduction to Law Enforcement use of sUAS
- Obtaining certificates of authorization or waiver (COAS) and Part 107 waivers
- Aerial search and seizure

FAA EXAM IS **NOT INCLUDED** IN THE COURSE. EXAM MUST BE SCHEDULED AND PAID FOR SEPARATELY.
