# **FARGO JET CENTER COMPLETES 10TH DEDICATED AIR MEDICAL AIRCRAFT FOR LIFE FLIGHT NETWORK**

**April 20, 2026 (Fargo, ND)** | Fargo Jet Center is proud to announce the completion and delivery of a newly outfitted, dedicated air medical Pilatus PC-12 for Life Flight Network, a not-for-profit patient transport service providing helicopter, fixed-wing, and ground ambulance transport throughout Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, and Hawai'i. The aircraft marks the 10th air medical conversion completed by Fargo Jet Center for Life Flight Network.

Medical equipment integrations on the newly completed PC-12 include:

- New Flightcell DZMX Plus Satcom/Flight Following System with SmartHub and cockpit camera
- New composite sidewall with stainless steel overlay for sanitation and durability
- Integrated upper medical sidewall with oxygen, air, vacuum, and power outlets
- FWD medical cabinet
- AMS43 TSO Cabin Audio Panel with 4 position cabin Intercom
- Cabin LED lighting upgrades and Cargo LED loading lights
- Spectrum Aeromed AFT baggage storage cabinet with LOX
- Dedicated medical cabin power system and high-power USB charging ports
- Spectrum Aeromed overhead Browline tracks for flexible equipment mounting and positioning
- Custom Loncoin flooring
- Lifeport Mission Style seats

Since 2017, Fargo Jet Center has delivered eight additional PC-12s and a Cessna Citation CJ4 to Life Flight Network. These aircraft provide ICU-level care during patient transport in the Pacific Northwest, Intermountain West and Hawai'i, and across the country.

"We are very proud to reach this milestone with Life Flight Network," said Mike Clancy, Vice President of Technical Services at Fargo Jet Center. "Pilots, providers and patients depend on advanced and safe medical transportation from Life Flight Network, and we are very grateful to be part of delivering that care when it matters most."

"Reaching 10 aircraft modifications with Fargo Jet Center is a testament to a partnership built on shared standards and trust," said Life Flight Network Senior Director of Maintenance, Chad McCracken.
